## Foreword

It is rare that women are able to tell their stories through conventional news media. It is even more complex when these stories are about sexual harassment despite the fact that women, world over, continue to face unchecked sexual harassment on a daily basis.

Keep Your Hands Off My Thighs, Ssebo is a compilation of fictionalized accounts of women who have experienced abuse at the workplace, intended to provide a basic and simplified understanding and context of sexual harassment at places of work from a feminist perspective.

These stories of fear, shame, blame and silence depict how the impunity around sexual abuse in the world of work has perpetuated a culture where women con-stantly bear the burden of public judgement and disbelief. Where you, dear reader, or a woman you know has experienced a form of violence shared here, all the ink in the world cannot express how much we believe you. While it is not our intention that you are triggered, receive love and light in the event that this hap-pens. We stand with you.


